Steinkrauss as chairman, president and chief executive officer. Steinkrauss was most recently chairman, president and CEO of Ingrian Networks, where he led the company to the leadership position in the data and application encryption market over the last 4 years. He brings nearly 35 years of executive leadership in security and networking to ChosenSecurity, which provides thousands of organizations worldwide with a range of security solutions based on proven public key infrastructure (PKI) technology.

Steinkrauss' track record is defined by strong company growth and successful mergers. Raptor Systems was the fastest growing software company in New England from 1994 to 1997. Before Raptor Systems, Steinkrauss was CEO of Racal InterLan and held various senior management positions within Racal Datacom and Unitrode Corporation.

The business communities on the West and East Coasts have both recognized Steinkrauss' achievements. This year, he was an Ernst & Young Entrepreneur of the Year finalist in northern

California for his work at Ingrian Networks. In 1997, he received the same honor in New England while he was CEO of Raptor Systems.

“I’m looking forward to getting involved as the CEO at ChosenSecurity, where I’ve been a member of the board of directors for some time and gotten to know the company very well,” said Steinkrauss. “The market for On Demand PKI solutions is quickly evolving and is opening up tremendous opportunities for ChosenSecurity.
